This year we will again be involved in the Great Western ANZAC Day March.

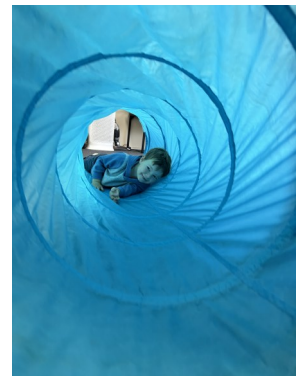
It is hoped that all students participate in this special event.
